
OMG, Van Eyck was here!

Activity:

Draw up a genealogy of the Van Eyck family. Indicate an unknown name or date by means of "?"



You need the names of all family members to draw up a genealogy. You also need to know their date of birth and, if applicable, their date of death. You need to know who was married to who, and how many children each couple had.

Many people enjoy finding out more about their family history. They ask their relatives everything they want to know.

If you're stuck, you can ask a genealogist for help. He or she will know exactly where to look. A genealogist will search the archives for birth certificates, letters, etc. Or visit an old cemetery to find out when someone died. This way, he or she will reconstruct the lineage of a family.

You will have to gather information from the different stories in the learning polyptych:

- X What names are mentioned in the stories?
- * Who are those people?
- Do they belong to the Van Eyck family?
- **** How are they related?
- When were they born?
- When did they die?
- What family members are unknown?

You will find all stories in the learning polyptych.
